JSI in the United States



JSI strives to enhance the health and well-being of women over the course of their lives. Addressing the key determinants of health to better understand and prevent diseases that disproportionately affect women, JSI promotes women's health and improved access to quality health care. JSI's network of experts train primary care, reproductive health, and community-based health care providers on evidence-based approaches to women's health. JSI also develops tools for organizations that serve women to improve delivery of family planning services, prenatal care, nutrition counseling, substance abuse and mental health treatment, and to prevent sexually transmitted infections and intimate partner violence.

Building Capacity to Serve Vulnerable Women and their Partners

Training and Technical Assistance – Building provider skills and organizations' capacity to provide high-quality health care services, in-person and through Web- and audio-based training technologies.

Service Integration – Working with providers, organizations, and communities to build holistic services and meet women's health needs more efficiently.

Grant Making – Supporting organizations that manage and administer funding to women's health organizations. JSI helps identify potential grantees, develop request for proposals, review and evaluate proposals, and implement and monitor grantee activities.

Coalition Building – Engaging and facilitating collaboration and decision-making between organizations, networks, and communities that have common goals. JSI facilitates wide-range partnerships and linkages among stakeholders to better plan and sustain their efforts.

Determining Critical Success Factors of Programs Serving Women

Program Evaluation – Establishing the effectiveness of prevention and service delivery programs, including those in the areas of prenatal care, adolescent pregnancy prevention, breast and cervical cancer screening, maternal and child health, and family planning.

Program Monitoring – Developing Web-based, 508-compliant management information systems to track and report program utilization and outcomes.

Improving Health through Education of Clients and Providers

Health Promotion – Creating health education materials for youth, limited-English speaking, low-literacy, and general audiences to increase access to and understanding of services and improve women's health outcomes.

Professional Education Materials Development – Creating continuing education materials for providers, including CEU-accredited curricula, online tutorials, and training videos.

JSI works with public and private clients to address the nation's most pressing health issues.
