Engagement of diverse community partners

- Raising awareness of social and environmental factors that influence teen pregnancy

Best Practices that address social determinants of teen pregnancy

- Development of strategies guided by best practice
- Implementation and evaluation of strategies
- Tools and resources to integrate strategies into all aspects of TPP project

Inclusive of female and male youth

- Engagement of young men in teen pregnancy prevention programs and clinical services
- Inclusion of LGBTQ youth
- Raising the “youth voice” through interviews with youth and producing the “Place Matters” video
- Strategies for recruitment and retention of diverse youth

Culturally competent, adolescent-centered care

- Promotion of community health workers in reaching diverse and vulnerable youth
- Raising awareness about the reproductive justice framework when promoting contraceptive access



5
Assessment of social determinants and linkage of youth to comprehensive services

- Equipping grantees with knowledge about history of adverse events and trauma and the importance of trauma-informed care
- Introducing the “whole teen” concept as a way to address social determinants impacting teen pregnancy
- Establishing community referral networks to meet the social/emotion/physical needs of youth in the community
