How to Use Mobile Money for Quick, Effective Distribution of Essential Malaria Commodities

The USAID | DELIVER PROJECT used an innovative mobile money (MoMo) solution to quickly distribute long-lasting insecticide treated bed nets (LLINs) across 13 districts in Rwanda

How did we set up the MoMo network?

Identified mobile money network:

MTN Rwanda works like a bank,
transferring money through
mobile phones and enabling individuals
to pick up the money from
agents in their villages.





Opened a **MoMo** account for the USAID | DELIVER PROJECT

Identified distributors to transfer cash for distribution of **LLINs**



Transferred 40,000-90,000 RWF to 157 Head of Health Centers and 10,000-25,000 RWF to 3,094 Community Health Workers (CHWs) and about 2,000 other health worker distributors



Distributed **I.4** million bed nets through CHWs from **766** sites across all **I3** districts



What makes this innovative and effective?



Reduced distribution costs by eliminating transport, per diem, and bank fees

Reduced leakage and waste of resources by streamlining distribution system





Increased efficiencies in staff time through reduced travel and labor

Systematized payment for CHWs, improving access to financial services





Strengthened linkage between central and community levels by engaging existing CHWs
