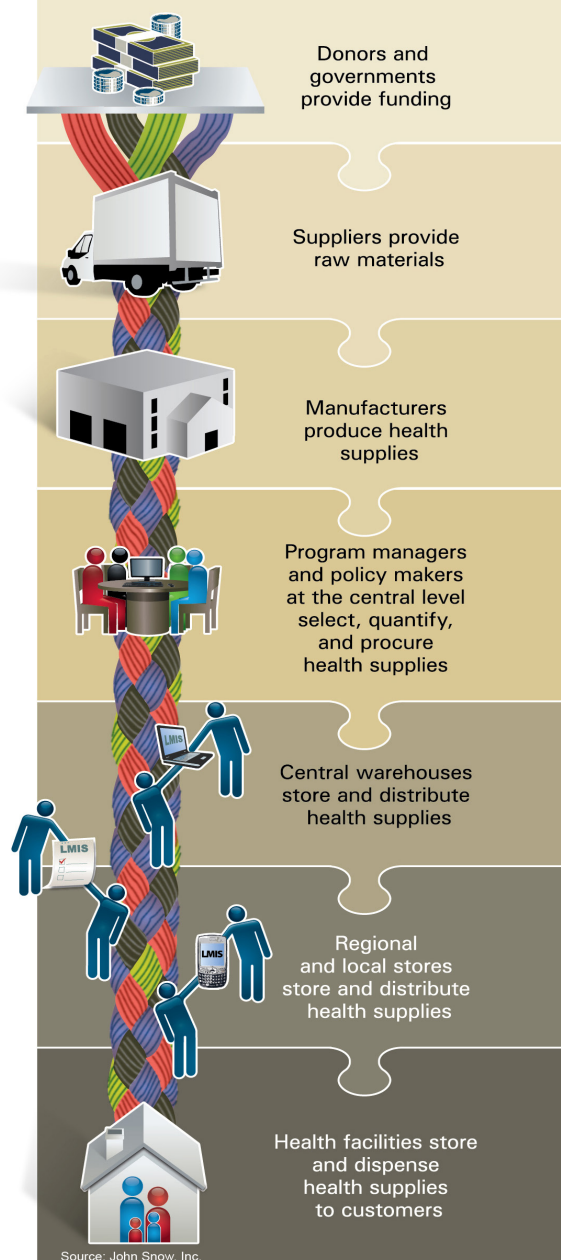
Build Stronger Supply Chains Over Time
